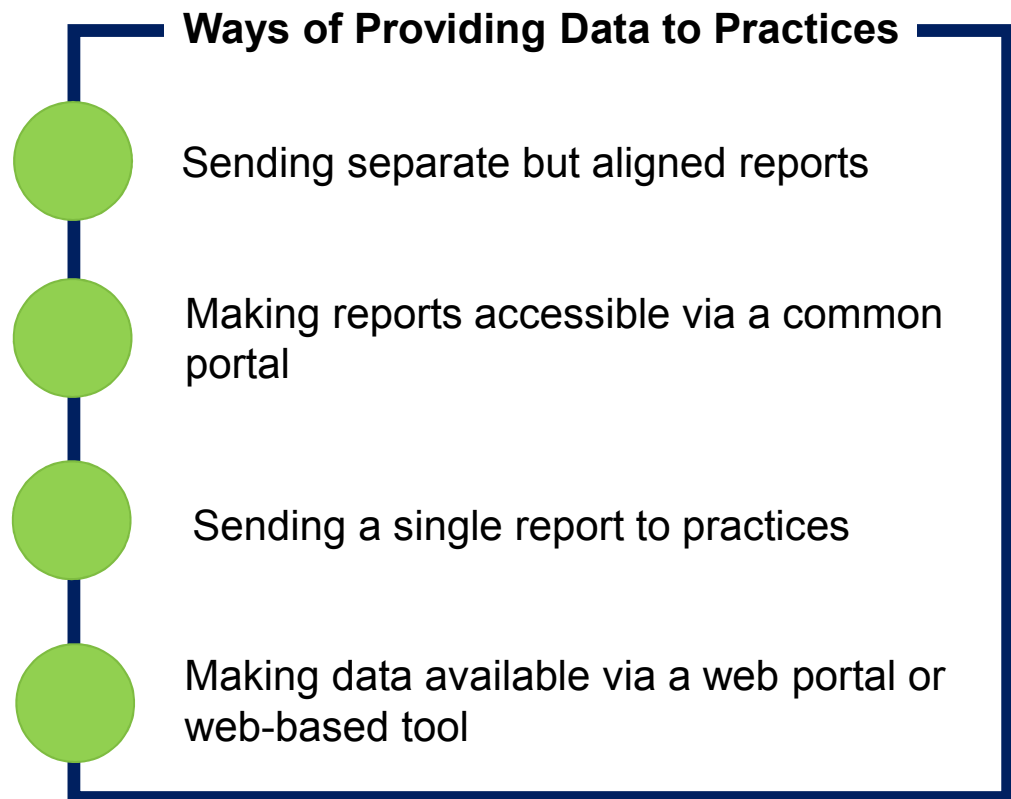

Data Alignment Approaches

✓ Aligning content/format of report to providers

- § Common report file format (e.g., Excel)
- § Common file layout
- § Common data elements

✓ Aggregating claims data or clinical data or both



Data Aggregation Approaches

Profile of Regions/States

Region/State	Approach
Colorado	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Providing aggregated claims data to practices via a single web portal• Payers are primarily driving and funding effort
Michigan	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Aggregating claims and clinical data from participating payers and practices through a statewide multi-payer database• Distributing data to practices through a web-based tool
Ohio	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sending practices aggregated claims data• State-wide HIE
Oklahoma	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Aggregating claims and clinical data from participating payers and practices through HIE• Send separate cost reports to the practices
Vermont	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sending practices aggregated claims and clinical data in separate reports• All-payer claims database
